1. **Clinical team award &**
2. **Non-clinical team award** - #respectandsupport #aspire to excellence #reflectlearnimprove. For teams who demonstrate best practice and/or drive forward improvements in patient care or have introduced a change in approach that has led to improvements in financial or operational performance. Or they may have pulled together through very difficult circumstances.
3. **Volunteer of the year (team or individual)** #respectandsupport. For volunteers who go the extra mile to help and support our patients, their relatives and our staff; acting as an advocate and offering a voice to our patients
4. **Quality improvement award** #aspiretoexcellence #reflectlearnimprove. Celebrating improvement and continuous progress. Nominees demonstrate creativity, flair and ambition to help services change and adapt to exceed expectations
5. **Unsung hero (clinical) &**
6. **Unsung hero (non-clinical)** #respectandsupport. Celebrating the heart and soul of NGH. These two awards go to individuals who go above and beyond the call of duty to support one another and ensure our patients get the best possible care
7. **Patient safety award (individual or team)** #patientsafetyaboveall else #aspiretoexcellence. For best practice in providing safe care, or have openly raised awareness of safety issues, championed transparency or introduced new, safer ways of working.
8. **Patient experience award (individual or team)** #bestpossible care. For those who place the patient's experience at the heart of all they do. They show they have listened to and acted on patient feedback.
9. **Clinical educator of the year** #reflectlearnimprove. For an individual or team who demonstrate excellence in providing and supporting high quality education
10. **Outstanding contribution award (individual)** #aspiretoexcellence. Recognising an individual or team who has inspired or brought about clear and demonstrable outcomes; who has worked above and beyond the call of duty in their service to our patients.
