

Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information received at Northampton General Hospital NHS Trust (NGH) on 09/01/19.

I am pleased to be able to provide you with the following information:

The data we require are as follows (for period 1st January 2018 and 31st December 2018) in an electronic format that allows us to read the data into a database. Many hospitals respond to our survey and provide data in the form we require. Preferably this format is in an excel file or comma separated text file.

We require the gender of the patient (M or F), the date that they attended due to assault (dd/mm/yyyy) and their age. Age can either be numerical to the nearest year (preferred) or in age bands ("0-10", "11-17", "18-30", "31-50", "51+"), we can also accept date of birth.

To calculate the level of assault-related injury in England and Wales we also require the total number of attendances for any reason in the year of interest, i.e. 2018.
