Thank you for your request for information received at Northampton General Hospital NHS Trust (NGH) on 17/06/2019.

How many Haemophilia A patients are registered at your hospital or treatment centre, and also how many Haemophilia B patients are registered with you.

If you could provide the data for both inpatient and outpatient I would be grateful

We are only able to identify outpatient attendances for those Haemophilia patients who have ever been an inpatient. Since 2004, 136 known Haemophilia patients have been seen at Northampton General Hospital.

I am trying to understand how patients are currently being treated. So, in the last three months of data that you can supply, how many Haemophilia A patients have been treated with:

Advate

Elocta

Novo Eight

Kogenate

Nuwiq

Refacto

Hemlibra

Factor eight inhibitor bypass activity

Novo Seven

Afstyla

Finally, have any been treated with Immune Tolerance Induction

And similarly for Haemophilia B, in the last three months, how many patients treated with:
